Communication Workshops

Communication Beyond Hearing Aids

Brisbane Hearing is introducing a new communication workshop for people who are hard of hearing, based on the ACE program developed at the University of Queensland.

Frequently, even people who wear hearing aids successfully, experience difficulty communicating in challenging listening environments. The workshops aim to assist participants to develop strategies to improve communication in everyday situations.

The program will benefit both people who wear hearing aids as well as those who choose not to use hearing aids.

A family member or friend is also welcome to attend. Hearing loss affects everyone.

The content of the program is tailored to each group's needs but may cover areas such as:

- ✓ Conversation in background noise
- ✓ Conversation around the house
- ✓ Communication with difficult speakers
- ✓ Listening to PA systems
- ✓ Listening to other signals

The workshop will encourage group participation to share experiences and strategies. Group numbers will be limited to eight participants.

The workshop involves two 90 minute sessions over consecutive weeks, and will include some take home exercises.

Morning tea will be provided.
